
CAUTION

- 5. The remote control must be held perpendicular to the projector's IR remote sensor to function correctly.




Plug the power cord into the outlet.

5 Select the correct input source on the projector or remote to project your device.




- First adjust the keystone to make the projection image rectangular, then slowly adjust the focus wheel to make the center clear. (Please use it in a dark environment.)

Connections instructions

The M8 projector can be connected to a variety of devices. Please prepare the corresponding adapter before connecting different devices

HDMI Connection

Use the HDMI slot to connect computers and HDMI-compatible devices. Once connected, select the HDMI signal source.



CONNECT TO A LAPTOP

1. Windows Laptop

To connect Windows laptop, please use the HDMI cable (included). Most Windows laptops support HDMI connection.



2. For MacBook

To connect the MacBook, you can use an Apple MFi-certified USB C to HDMI adapter or an Apple MFi-certified Thunderbolt to HDMI adapter.



CONNECT YOUR IOS DEVICE

there are two ways to connect your iPhone/iPad: wireless and wired.

1, Wireless: Wireless WiFi Connection

Note:

- ① The fluency of scrimbling wirelessly is related to the network environment. We recommend screen-mirroring with wireless in a stable environment. A bandwidth of 100Mbit or more is recommended when using screen mirroring.

< Wireless > Click the button.




4 Enter your home WiFi password and then connect.

Note: Go to Settings on your iOS device and turn on the Wi-Fi feature →→ Connect your iOS device to the same WiFi as your projector.


- ①. Open Control Center on your iOS device. Select the Screen Mirroring function.
- ②. Click "WINDELE-xxx" to enter the image.
- 3). When the connection is successful, the image of the smartphone will be displayed on the projector.


1. With Apple Lightning Digital AV Adapter

Please use an official HDMI to Apple Lightning Digital AV Adapter from the Apple store (not included).



2. With a Miracast/Dongle

Miracast is designed for mirroring a smartphone, tablet, or PC's screen to a bigger screen. You can use a Mira cast/Donqle to realize the wireless connection.



CONNECT TO ANDROID DEVICES

There are both wireless and wired ways to connect to Android devices.

1. Wireless: Wireless WiFi Connection

NOTE:

- ① The fluency of scrimbling wirelessly is related to the network environment. We recommend screen-mirroring with wireless in a stable environment. A bandwidth of 100Mbit or more is recommended when using screen mirroring.

Android Screen mirroring



① On the home page, select <Screen mirroring> menu.



 Make sure that the Android device is connected to the same network as the projector.



2 Select the < Android> system.

- 1 Turn on WIFI on your Android device.
- 2 Launch the "multi-screen" function on your Android device and search for the projector.
- 3 Select "WINDELE-XXXXXX" from the search results and connect.






NOTE: For compatibility reasons, some Android devices may not have screen mirroring.

NOTE: Please refer to the pictures below as an example.

The display of the smartphone screen depends on the model and Settings.



NOTE:


- ① The button of the [screen mirroring] function of the smartphone can be used to display "multi-screen", "/ wireless display", "/ WLAN display", "/ screen mirroring" or "smart view". I do.
- ② Not all Android smartphones support this feature, usually support Android 8.0 and above smartphones. Make sure it is supported before using.

2. Wired: Miracast or HDMI switching adapter is required

You can use Miracast/dogle to connect to your Android phone.

Alternatively, connect with an HDMI switching adapter.

Note: Please confirm whether the mobile phone you are using has screen mirror function.



Bluetooth Speaker Setup



① Select the BT menu on the home page.



- ① Put [BT Mode] that's it. Open the Bluetooth device you want to connect to
- ② Click [Available Release] to start/stop searching for nearby Bluetooth devices.




Note: Right click on the remote to search for Bluetooth devices


- ③ Select the Bluetooth device you want to connect to, press OK, and wait a few seconds for the Bluetooth connection to succeed.

NOTE:

- ① Only Bluetooth headsets and Bluetooth speakers can be connected, but Bluetooth keyboards and Bluetooth phones cannot be connected.
- ② Bluetooth function can only support MP3 and AAC audio form, other forms of audio can not play or play with Bluetooth has no sound.
- ③ Please place the Bluetooth speaker you want to connect near the projector. If the Bluetooth speaker cannot be searched, please restart the Bluetooth speaker.

Airpords: Open Airpords and long press the button behind it for 3 to 4 seconds to search for Airpords and connect







CONNECTION TO DVD PLAYER


NOTE:

In the case of no sound connected to the TV recorder, some videos cannot transmit signals to the outside for copyright protection. Video <Sound mode >


Please change to PCM mode.

Use the supplied 3-in-1 AV cable

- 1) Power on the DVD player and projector.
- ② Using the 3-in-1 AV cage in the package, connect the colored mesco connector to the RCA cable of the DVD player.
- ③ Connect the black connector to the AV port of the projector and go to the home page to select the [AV] signal source. Or use the included HDMI cable to connect to a DVD player.

External Speaker/Soundbar Connection


To connect with headphones/wired speakers, a 3.5mm audio cable is used as shown below to connect the projector to headphones/wired speakers.

NOTE:

A condition in which there is no sound from an external device

Reason: Some PIDIos in the Netflix app and prime video app cannot transmit signals externally due to copyright protection.


Solution: To protect copyright, some Pidio can't transmit signals. Please change the sound mode of the video to PCM mode



USB CONNECTION

Step 1

Select Play File.



AV CONNECTION


The projector was connected using a 3-in-1 AV cable as shown below. Once connected, the AV signal source is selected.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

Q: There is no sound when playing Netflix videos?

A: Due to copyright reasons, some videos or streaming software(e. g Netflix, Disney+, Hulu, etc.) themselves do not support Screen Mirroring. This is a common phenomenon in the market.

*HDMI connections help FUDONI Spare-P2 projector on this issue:

①For iPhone, you can use an Apple Lightning Digital AV Adapter. Most streaming software works well via this adapter.

②For fire stick, Roku, and Chromecast, streaming software will also work well.

3 Connect the PC or laptop via the HDMI cable.

Q: The Power doesn't work

Α.

- (1) make sure that the power cable is properly inserted.
- (2) remove the lens cover and press and hold the power button for about 3 seconds.
- (3) if it cannot be repaired by the above method, please contact after-sales service. We will exchange a new one.

Q: The Power goes off during use

Α:

- (1) did you set "auto off" in the timer menu to "on (select time)"? Did you set the "power off time" to "on (select time)"?
- (2) check if the plug of the power cable is properly inserted. (3) is the projector ventilated off?
- (4) voltage is not stable.(5) has it been running for a long time, causing overheating protection system?

Q: I can't get the footage.

Α.

- (1) have you chosen the correct input source?
- (2) is the cable of the input terminal connected correctly? If that doesn't help, try reset.

Q: I can't hear the sound when I connect to the TV recorder.

Α.

- (1) please change the dolby mode of the video to PCM mode due to copyright.
- (2) some videos in Netflflix app or prime video app cannot transmit signals externally due to copyright protection (HDCP consultation).

O: Connect to a Bluetooth device and it does not make a sound.

Α.

- (1) Please confirm whether the projector is supported by the playback file.
- (2) Please confirm whether the entity software has been upgraded? If you do not know the method of software upgrade, please consult the after-sales service.

Q: Cannot mirror with smartphone.

A: Connect the iOS device to the WiF of the projector.

Please mirror the screen in a stable environment.

Please restart the smartphone and projector.

O: Unable to connect Bluetooth

A: Please place the Bluetooth device near the projector. Please restart the Bluetooth and projector devices

O: There was no sound.

A: In order to protect copyright, some videos cannot transmit signals to the outside world. Video sound mode

- (2) Please change to PCM mode.
- (2) Adjust the volume with the remote control.
- (3) Make sure you're in etiquette mode.
- (4) Please try the u disk, music, etc., to confirm whether it is the problem of the video (input source).

Q: How to upside down the picture?

A: Please go to Menu > Setting > Rotate to flip the projection picture as your needs.

Q: Why isn't the projector bright enough?

A: Because this product is a home projector, please use it in a dark environment.

Q: Why is the image blurry?

A: Is the lens focused correctly?

Is the Angle between the projection screen and the machine set correct?

Does the projection distance exceed the focus range?

Make sure the projection lens is dirty.

The most appropriate projection distance is 1.5m to 3m.

Please adjust the key stone and turn it into a rectangular display. Slowly turn the focus dial to adjust the focus

O: There was no sound.

A: In order to protect copyright, some videos cannot transmit signals to the outside world. Video sound mode

- (1) Please change to PCM mode.
- (2) Adjust the volume with the remote control.
- (3) Make sure you're in etiquette mode.
- (4) Please try the u disk, music, etc., to confirm whether it is the problem of the video (input source).

Q: Image warping

A: Is it set up correctly?

If the distortion is trapezoidal, do trapezoidal correction.

The top or bottom length of the image (trapezoidal distortion)

Is the projector positioned as perpendicular to the screen as possible? Please use the solid key ring to correct the trapezoidal distortion.

Q: The power cut off in use

Α:

- 1. When the projector is used continuously for a long time, it will automatically start the overheating protection. Wait 10 minutes or so to restart automatically.
- 2. Please confirm whether the plug of the power cable is inserted properly.

Q: Cannot be operated with the remote control

A: Is the remote control sending part of the remote control facing the light receiving part of the remote control of the host?

Did the remote control battery drain? Please replace the batteries with new ones.

Is there an obstacle between the remote control and the light receiving part of the remote control of the host?

Not beyond the effective range of the remote control.

Q: How is the image scaled (shrunk)?

A: The projector's picture can be reduced to as little as 50%.

Go to the Home Page Settings, then in the Photo interface & It; zoom mode & gt; Click, as per your request Can reduce the size of the hand screen

Note: When the screen size is reduced, the size of the main screen and the set screen are unchanged, and the size of the animation screen is reduced.
